

Confidentiality Statement

- 1.1. The translator understands that the translator will, in the course of providing services to ABC, be exposed to and have access to sensitive and confidential matters, and that the translator is required to maintain strict confidentiality over all products, designs, information and matters which come to the translator's attention through ABC directly or indirectly.

The translator agrees to take all steps necessary to protect the security of and avoid disclosure of the confidential information, and will ensure that all employees and/or subcontractors of the translator will agree and abide by the same confidentiality and proprietary standards as are required under this agreement for the translator.

ABC invested significant resources in maintaining its relationships with its clients and its professional reputation in the industry as part of those efforts ABC takes great care to protect its client's confidential and proprietary information. The translator acknowledges that ABC will suffer significant damages if the translator breaches any of the confidentiality or proprietary clauses contained in this agreement.

All obligations of confidentiality extend to all online postings the translator may make and websites the translator may maintain or contribution content to whether or not such postings or websites are accessible by the general public were a select group and whether or not done on an anonymous basis or a attributable to the translator.
